

Ask Our Experts Episode 19: All about Cybersecurity- Beyond the Buzz

The National e-Governance Division (NeGD), Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) aired the 19th episode of 'Ask Our Experts'- a You Tube LIVE program, on **'Cyber Security'** on April 25, 2025.

The experts present in this episode were Shri Sushil Kumar Nehra, Director, Cyber Security Division, MeitY and Shri Anuj Agarwal, Joint Director, Cyber Security Division, MeitY.

The episode delved deep into the various types of growing cyber security threats and different ways a common citizen can tackle them along with a detailed explanation of threats such as ransomware attacks. Insights were also shared on how to be alert and aware of common cyber frauds and small steps that can be taken to save oneself from falling prey to them.

The experts also talked about the important standards that an organization should have in place to safeguard itself from cyber attacks. Mr. Nehra said that ISO 2700, a globally recognised international standard, provides a framework for organisations to establish, implement, maintain, and continually improve their Information Security Management System (ISMS).
