NeGD Announces Integration of Punjab Labour Department Services with DigiLocker

The **National e-Governance Division (NeGD)**, **Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology** is pleased to announce the successful integration of the **Department of Labour, Government of Punjab's services** with **DigiLocker**, a flagship initiative under the *Digital India* programme. This integration, carried out in collaboration with the **NIC Punjab State Centre**, marks a significant step in enabling digital access to essential labour records for citizens.

Through this initiative, workers can now securely access and store certificates issued by the Punjab Labour Department in DigiLocker. Starting with the **Registration of Construction Workers service**, certificates dating back to 2013 will be made available digitally. To date, over **7,71,688 certificates** are eligible for retrieval.
