Students explore Digital India initiatives via engaging sessions

New Delhi: The National e-Governance Division (NeGD), MeitY, organised a Digital India Awareness Workshop at Bharati Vidyapeeth Institute of Computer Applications and Management (BVICAM), New Delhi, on January 21, 2026.

The event kicked off with an inaugural address by Prof. M.N. Huda, Director, BVICAM in the presence of Dr. S.N. Bhandarkar and Prof. Renu Tandon from G.G.S.I.P.U. and Dr. Rakhee Sharma.
