



Episode 39 of Digital India Ask Our Experts Highlights Upcoming New Aadhaar App

New Delhi: The 39th episode of the Digital India Ask Our Experts series focused on the soon-to-be-launched new Aadhaar app by the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI). The episode highlighted how the app aims to reimagine digital identity by making it more secure, verifiable, and privacy-focused.

The session featured Vivek C. Verma, Deputy Director General, UIDAI, and Tanusree Deb Barma, Deputy Director General, UIDAI, who shared insights on the vision, features, and resident-centric design of the new Aadhaar app while addressing key questions in simple and clear language.

Our experts explained that the new Aadhaar app is designed to simplify Aadhaar usage and will give people greater control over sharing of their personal information. The new app, once dedicated to the nation, will reduce the need to carry physical Aadhaar cards or photocopies by enabling digital and offline verification.

Several features of the new app were discussed, including the QR code-based offline verification, Aadhaar update services, selective sharing of data, and managing multiple Aadhaar profiles in one app, among others. The discussion also touched upon how it is aligned with the Digital India vision of a trusted, people-centric digital ecosystem.
